

nanairoGrade (Demo)

Setup Guide (Windows)

Product Version: v1.1.0 (Demo)

Target App: Adobe Premiere Pro (Windows)

This guide covers installing the Free Demo Version to getting started in Premiere Pro.

In short, all you need to do is run the Setup EXE file.

1. System Requirements

- OS: Windows 11 (64-bit)
- Host App: Adobe Premiere Pro 25.6 or later
- GPU: NVIDIA GPU with CUDA support recommended. (In environments without CUDA support, the plugin will operate with CPU fallback.)
- Permissions: Administrator privileges are required during installation.
- Other: The Adobe Creative Cloud desktop app is required to install the UXP panel.

2. Included Files & Installed Components

- Effect File: nanairoGrade_Demo.aex
- Control Panel: nanairoGrade_Demo.ccx

3. Installation Procedure

Example Filename: nanairoGrade_Demo_Setup_Windows_v1.1.0.exe

1. Close Adobe Premiere Pro completely (ensure it is entirely shut down).
2. Double-click the setup file (nanairoGrade_Demo_Setup_Windows_v*.exe) to run it.
3. If the User Account Control (UAC) prompt appears, click "Yes".
4. Follow the on-screen instructions in the installer.

5. If the UXP panel (.ccx) installation screen appears during the process, click "Install" (or "Yes") to install the panel as well. *A warning may appear stating that this is an external plugin not from the Marketplace. Please proceed and click "Install".
6. Once the installation is complete, launch Premiere Pro.

4. How to Use in Premiere Pro

The basic workflow is similar to using Lumetri Color. Instead of dragging and dropping from the Effects panel, you simply select a clip on your timeline and adjust the parameters directly from the nanairoGrade_Demo panel.

【Opening the Panel】

1. In the Premiere Pro top menu, go to Window > UXP Plugins > nanairoGrade_Demo.
2. Once opened and docked, the panel will remain in your workspace layout as long as you use the same workspace.
3. If you close the panel or switch workspaces, you can reopen it from the menu.

【Applying & Adjusting Looks】

1. Select the target clip on your timeline.
2. Adjust the sliders on the nanairoGrade_Demo panel.
3. The effect will be automatically applied to the selected clip, allowing you to seamlessly blend and adjust the looks.

【Recommended Gamma Setting (1.96)】

This plugin is designed around "Gamma 1.96" to prevent the colors from looking washed out after export (the common QuickTime gamma shift issue), optimizing your videos for viewing on PCs, smartphones, YouTube, and social media.

When grading, we recommend opening the [Settings] tab at the top of the "Lumetri Color" panel and configuring the following two settings:

- Check the box for [Display Color Management].
- Set the "Viewer Gamma" under Project Settings to [1.96 (QuickTime)].

*You can still use the plugin without issues under the default [2.4 (Broadcast)] setting; however, the effect will reflect with slightly stronger contrast. If using Gamma 2.4, simply adjust the blend amount using the panel sliders to your preference.

Tip:

You can also apply the effect manually by dragging and dropping "nanairoGrade_Demo" from the Effects panel onto your clip. If the effect is not automatically applied when moving a panel slider, please try this manual method.

Note:

If the panel is grayed out or unresponsive, please ensure that a valid video clip is actively selected on your timeline.

5. Upgrading to the Full Version

Thank you for trying out the Demo version of nanairoGrade! Please note that installing the Full Version will not overwrite or remove the Demo version; both can co-exist in Premiere Pro. After purchasing and installing the Full Version, you can safely uninstall the Demo version if it is no longer needed.

- Please make sure to close Premiere Pro completely before installing.
- When the panel confirmation screen appears during installation, click "Install" to proceed.

6. Uninstallation

1. Close Premiere Pro completely.
2. Go to Windows Settings > Apps > Installed apps, locate "nanairoGrade_Demo", and select Uninstall.
3. Open the Adobe Creative Cloud desktop app and navigate to "Manage Plugins".
(You can also access this directly in Premiere Pro by going to Plugins > Manage Plugins.)
4. Find "nanairoGrade_Demo" in the list, click the three dots (...) menu, and select Uninstall.
5. Restart Premiere Pro if necessary.

*Note: Uninstalling via Windows Settings only removes the core effect file (.aex). To remove the control panel (.ccx), please make sure to uninstall it separately via Manage Plugins as described in the steps above.

7. Troubleshooting

【nanairoGrade_Demo does not appear in the effect panel or menu】

- Completely close and restart Premiere Pro.
- Check if you have multiple or different versions of Premiere Pro running simultaneously.
- Run the Setup EXE again.
- Make sure you did not skip or cancel the .ccx panel installation step during setup.
- Check if "nanairoGrade_Demo" is listed under Window > UXP Plugins.

【The panel is unresponsive】

- Ensure that a target clip is actively selected on your timeline.
- Re-run the Setup EXE to reinstall the panel.

【Preview is laggy / Doesn't seem to use GPU acceleration】

- Update your NVIDIA graphics drivers to the latest "Studio Driver".
- Check your Premiere Pro Project Settings and ensure the Mercury Playback Engine is set to GPU Acceleration (CUDA).
